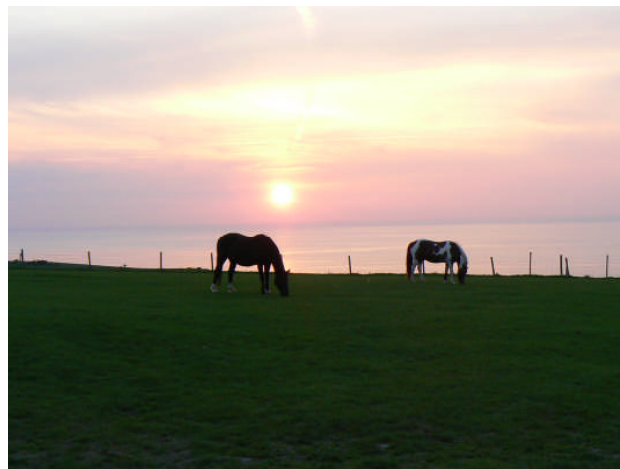
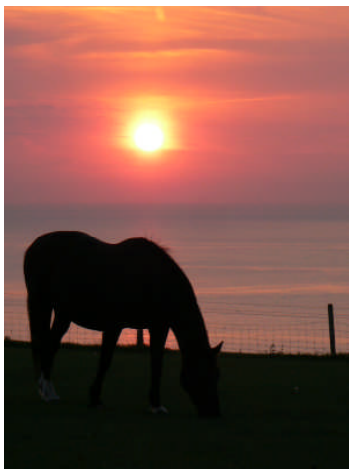


## Meet our resident horses

Each month we will be introducing you to some new and old friends from the centre, we start with two very special horses

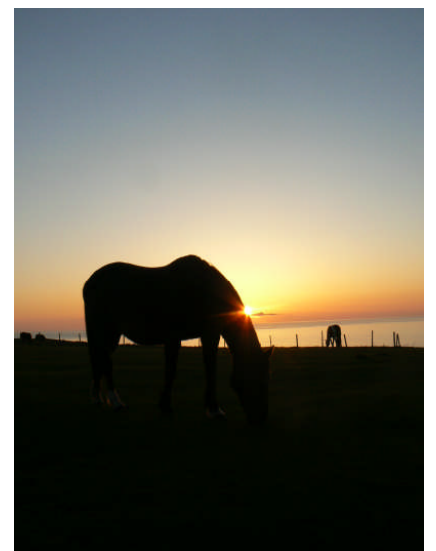
### Simon & Milly

**Simon:**

Part warmblood, 29 years of age, skewbald gelding. 15 hh

Simon is now 29 and is best friends to Milly. He came to the centre with Julianne as he was given to her in 1999, and became her own veteran. Having been shown successfully by Julianne since 2000 he went on to many county wins and qualifications.

Now he is fully retired due to a tendon injury and does suffer from arthritis. Having been retired for 2 years has given problems with his weight, so he is restricted for most of the day. Being allowed 3 hours good grazing each evening.

Simon loves in hand showing, despite his injury he is taken to a couple of local shows to give him some interest.

Being Julianne's own horse for 10 years he has helped promote the Society and the care and welfare of older horses. He is always bandaged when stabled and has a range of rugs, as do all the horses at the centre, in fact 3 indoor and 3 outdoor all different weights according to each days weather

Today Simon enjoys relaxing at the Centre with close companion Milly. He is still stabled during the evenings until the weather turns much warmer.

**Milly**

29 year old, Black, Warmblood Mare, 15.3 hh

Milly is a 29 year old 15.3 hh warmblood mare, who's father was a very famous dressage horse in the 1970's. A beautiful black Warmblood stallion he won medals at the 1970's Olympics and is still today one of the most famous dressage horses – Dutch Courage.

Milly has a very flighty temperament and seems to get a little worse each year, but is a very loving little mare and adores Simon. With a striking personality, pace and features, she is one of the most elegant mares the centre cares for. Her arrival in 2002 was the beginning of a beautiful friendship between her and Simon her 29 year old companion.

She has a range of rugs, that are kindly sponsored by Shires Equestrian, like all the other horses at the centre she has 3 indoor rugs and 3 outdoor rugs, each is according to the weather and temperature

Her diet during the summer is very simple  
Fibregy and High fibre cubes with garlic

Her diet in the winter will include  
Grass replacement, just as Just Grass  
Sugarbeet  
Country Cubes or 16+  
Garlic  
Dynamo  
Play ball is fed at 6pm each evening 2lb (1 scoop) High Fibre Cubes
